Getting organized before meeting with your CPA can save you time and money. Here's what you'll need...

INCOME

- O W-2's
- O 1099-MISC or 1099-NEC for work performed as a contractor, rents, or royalties
- O 1099-INT for interest income received
- O 1099-DIV for dividend income received
- O 1099-B or Consolidated 1099 statement for investment income
- O 1099-G for tax refunds and unemployment income
- O 1099-SSA for social security income
- O 1099-R for retirement distributions
- O K-1's from partnerships or s corporations you own
- O Business or farm income and expenses
- O Rental income and expenses
- O Gambling winnings

ADJUSTMENTS

- O 1098-E for student loan interest
- O 1099-T for tuition expenses
- O Health Savings Account (HSA) contributions
- O Moving expenses
- O Health insurance premiums for self-employed taxpayers
- O Retirement contributions
- O Educator expenses

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DEDUCTIONS & CREDITS

- O Medical and dental expenses
- O State and local taxes
- O Real estate taxes
- O Vehicle taxes
- O 1098's for mortgage interest
- O Deductible points and mortgage insurance premiums
- O Investment interest expense
- O Charitable contributions (cash and non-cash)
- O Home office expenses (rent, insurance, utilities, parking, repairs, etc.)
- O Business vehicle expenses (lease payments, gas, repairs, insurance, etc.)
- O Solar and other energy efficient improvements
- O Child and dependent care expenses

OTHER

- O Estimated taxes
- O Extension payments
- O SSN and birthdate of new dependents
- O Foreign bank account information
- O Stock option exercises
- O Major purchases or sales (house, car, etc.)

- O Gifts in excess of annual exclusion (\$16,000 for 2022)
